Radio Monitoring

Marine Rescue Bunbury does not currently have an active 24 x 7 radio listening watch.

Marine radio coverage is provided by Australian Coastal Radio Monitors (ACRM WA) based in Capel and Busselton. ACRM WA cover from Preston Beach to Margaret River on 27.880 MHz marine radio, VHF Marine Radio channels 80 and 22 and on UHF CB channel 6.
